



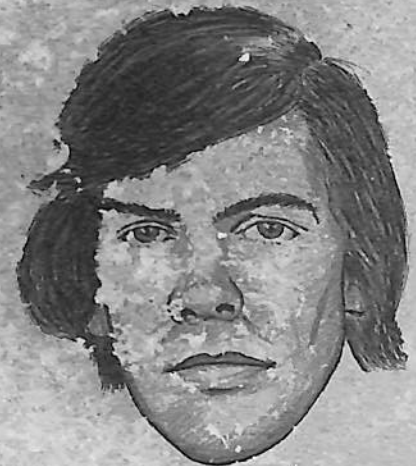

LOU HOLTZ

Welcome back, Lou.

You remember Lou Holtz, Rick Forzano's football assistant at UConn from 1964 to 1966. Lou Holtz has come a long way up the ladder since then. And tonight, Lou follows Forzano, guest speaker last year, to the UConn Club rostrum.

The 39-year-old West Virginia native played high school sports in East Liverpool, Ohio, before performing as center and linebacker four years at Kent State.

He started his coaching career where he graduated and was an aide at Iowa, William and Mary, UConn, South Carolina and Ohio State before landing his first top job at William and Mary.

He guided the men of Williamsburg to their first bowl game in 24 years and their first Southern Conference title in 23.

Lou moved ahead to North Carolina State in 1972 and reversed the football program there. He took the Wolfpack to an Atlantic Coast Conference championship and four straight post-season appearances with a combined record of 33-12-3.

He was selected coach of the year by a number of groups and just last week he joined the company of Bear Bryant, Weeb Ewbank, Gen. Douglas MacArthur, Don Shula and Amos Alonzo Stagg as recipient of the Touchdown Club of America's 42d annual award.

An amateur magician, he was signed to practice sleight of hand on the slumping New York Jets this year. "My favorite magic trick is the rope trick. If it doesn't work you can always hang yourself with it," he wise-cracked to newsmen.

"I believe in God, Lou Holtz and the New York Jets, just about in that order," is another of Lou's one-liners. Judging by that witticism, Lou Holtz should do well in the pro ranks.

O'Neill Award

Honors on and off the athletic fields have been many for Bill Makofski. But he has never tired of sports since departing Storrs 50 years ago where he earned 12 letters.

His career at Connecticut was illustrious, having starred in baseball, basketball and football. He captained the hoop squad in his senior year, winning all-New England honors.

Bill played on Sumner Dole's undefeated 1924 eleven, the only unbeaten team in the school's history. He was a roommate and teammate of the captain of that club, Red O'Neill, for whom his award tonight is named.

After leaving UConn, he played minor league baseball, basketball and football, and wound up officiating 1,304 basketball games at scholastic, college and pro levels. He also helped recruit athletes for UConn.

An accountant in his hometown of Schenectady, N.Y., Bill holds a lifetime fellowship in the Kiwanis Foundation. He worked diligently since the late 20s in behalf of youth organizations in Schenectady.

Who would have figured that the UConn basketball team would close its season as one of the top 16 in the nation when it had a 13-9 record on January 26.

And about that same time, this man was the target of much derision. His intense desire, his devotion to the game, and his faith in his players would not allow Dee Rowe to abandon hope.

The Huskies turned it all around, winning the next six including triumphs over UMass and Providence in the ECAC tournament and Hofstra in the NCAA East Regional semi-finals.

Coaches look on every game as one they must win. But Dee Rowe brought the Huskies through clutch situations with success countless times in his seven years at Storrs. We're mighty pleased that he's still around.

A 1952 graduate of Middlebury, the 47-year-old native of Worcester, Mass., also earned a master of education degree from Boston University. He was athletic director and basketball coach at Worcester Academy 13 years where his hoop teams won 180, lost 45 and captured nine New England titles.

Dee's UConn quintets posted an overall 103-78 record, made two NIT appearances, played in a pair of ECAC tournaments, and gained the trip to Greensboro. And that's why his peers named him New England Coach of the Year for 1976.

O'Neill Award

Nate Lipman once considered running for political office. A law associate persuaded him not to because his friend advised him that he didn't talk enough and was too honest. That's Nate.

Son of Lithuanian immigrants, Nate starred in baseball, basketball and football in his hometown of New Britain. He was a catcher for the renowned Falcons of the New Britain dusty baseball loop.

He was a stellar performer in baseball and basketball in the early 30s at UConn where he got his degree in 1935. He graduated Boston University Law School in 1939 and has practiced in New Britain since, except for a tour of overseas duty with the Army in World War II.

Unassuming Nate made his mark in athletics in sure, steady fashion. His generous contributions to the UConn sports scene the past 40 years have been made in the same manner.

Nate served on the UConn Club Board of Directors many years. He's presently battling an illness that forced him into lengthy convalescence. There are plenty of people in your corner, Nate!

Ingalls Award

Named in honor of the late University of Connecticut football coach and assistant athletic director, D. Robert Ingalls, this award is presented annually to the captain, or co-captains, of the Husky football team.

This year, the award is shared by last season's co-captains, Richard J. Fenton and Allan D. MacLellan.

Fenton, a six-foot, 195-pound safety from Enfield, holds the UConn season record for pass interceptions (7). He majored in English.

MacLellan, six-foot, three-inch, 215-pound tight end from Tewksbury, Mass., holds UConn career pass receiving records of 84 receptions and 1,128 yards. He also majored in English.



Outstanding Senior Athlete Award

Last year, Donny Thompson won this award for his football heroics. Now, John Thomas. It's that bountiful Bogalusa (La.) Connection working again, for which we are grateful to alumnus Ken Vernon.

How long John Thomas, 6-foot-8 Husky center, is viewed by the media is unique. He was named both New England Player of the Year and Unsung Player of the Year.

Whatever, the dean's list student fits both roles and he certainly was vital to UConn's successful 19-10 season.

Thomas was fourth in the country in total rebounds (402) and finished his college career with 1,023. He also scored 728 points at UConn.

A dedicated athlete with an admirable attitude, Thomas once won all-district and state honors at Bogalusa. Now he ranks with UConn all-time backboard greats Kimball, Quimby and Corley. Perhaps he's the greatest.

Outstanding Senior Athlete Award

Where have all the good boys gone? Well, Al Weston cast his lot with UConn and the end result was mutual satisfaction, indeed.

The long-range, clutch shooting of the soft-spoken Cromwell athlete created plenty of noise in the Field House on many cold, winter nights.

Weston, 5-foot-10 guard and quick as a cat, was the only high school player in the state's history to be selected all-state in basketball all four years.

Last season, he posted double figures in UConn's last 19 games and scored 24 points to lead the Huskies in the losing finale with Rutgers.

Al finished the season with 373 points and a 14.9 average. But over four years at Storrs, he contributed 1,342 points, moving into fourth place among all-time UConn scorers.

The Red O'Neill Story

The development of an award in Red O'Neill's memory did not occur accidentally. For two years a UConn Club award committee researched various possibilities. Despite the many alumni considered all signs pointed to the Redhead as the man who combined the highest attributes of character, leadership, athletic ability and, later, a successful career.

The O'Neill Award is given annually to UConn men who have gone from the athletic fields to distinguish themselves in their chosen careers.

As an outstanding athlete, Red had to overcome the severe handicap of a silver plate in his right arm, the result of a World War I wound. In 1924 he was the captain and fullback of the only unbeaten football team in UConn history.

As a student he was brilliant, getting top honors. After graduation in 1925, he went to the Yale Medical School. As a surgeon he was well known. In his later years, he was known for his work in obstetrics. He gave 23 years of his life to medicine before passing away in 1955.
