## WALTER NADZAK JR.

More than 80 candidates were screened before the decision was reached to appoint Walter Nadzak Jr. head football coach at the University of Connecticut.

Nadzak became the sixth Husky gridiron guide over the past 16 years — a span that includes just four winning seasons.

Assertive. Positive. Zealous. They fit this 40-year-old former Marine officer who spent his boyhood in the far western Pennsylvania village of Ambridge.

He learned his trade well at Denison University where he earned All-Ohio Conference honors three times while performing in the football trenches. A 1957 graduate of the Granville Ohio, institution, he also received a master's degree in education from Xavier.

Nadzak coached football and directed the athletic program the past eight years at Juniata College, nestled in the clay and coal regions of the Appalachian Mountains in his home state. That's football country. His record stands 45 wins, 26 losses and three ties with his last two seasons back-to-back 6-3 campaigns.

Four years ago, his Indians of the Mid-Atlantic Conference captured National Division III runner-up honors and he was selected Division III, District II Coach of the Year.

Nadzak, his wife Shirley, and their children, Cary, Tracy, Walter III, and Jeffrey, will forsake allegiance to Navy and Gold for the Blue and White.

And Walt will be concentrating on Delaware, Navy, Rutgers and Yale, rather than Albright, Lycoming, Susquehanna and Wilkes.

### O'Neill Award

Thaddeus R. Sobieski  
Class of '51



A charter member of the UConn Club, whose attributes couldn't parallel more closely those of the gallant Redhead, is tonight's O'Neill recipient.

"Sobie's" dedication was exemplary on fields of friendly strife, on the unfriendly terrain of Korea, and in the complex domain of labor law.

The 50-year-old Meriden native played tackle for the 1947 Fort Trumbull UConn Branch that finished 7-1 during his first semester, following an Air Corps stint near the end of World War II.

He lettered in football three years at Storrs and co-captained the 1950 squad. He also was selected to the Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities. After graduation, he served in Korea as an infantry lieutenant. There he earned the Silver Star, among other decorations.

Currently an Army Reserve lieutenant colonel and a litigation expert for the National Labor Relations Board, Sobie and his wife, Rosa Marie, reside in Atlanta, where he also received a law degree in 1958 from Emory University.

### *The Red O'Neill Story*

The development of an award in Red O'Neill's memory did not occur accidentally. For two years a UConn Club award committee researched various possibilities. Despite the many alumni considered all signs pointed to the Redhead as the man who combined the highest attributes of character, leadership, athletic ability and, later, a successful career.

The O'Neill Award is given annually to UConn men who have gone from the athletic fields to distinguish themselves in their chosen careers.

As an outstanding athlete, Red had to overcome the severe handicap of a silver plate in his right arm, the result of a World War I wound. In 1924 he was the captain and fullback of the only unbeaten football team in UConn history.

As a student he was brilliant, getting top honors. After graduation in 1925, he went to the Yale Medical School. As a surgeon he was well known. In his later years, he was known for his work in obstetrics. He gave 23 years of his life to medicine before passing away in 1955.

— during the last five years of his eight years at Storrs, the Huskies played in the NCAA tournament and reached East finals twice while annexing New England and Yankee Conference crowns.

— over the past three years, UConn compiled an overall 53-7-6 soccer record.

— eight Husky booters were named All-Americans and Morrone was twice chosen New England Coach of the Year.

The innovative 41-year-old, 1958 UMass graduate, named that school's Outstanding Senior Athlete as a soccer, hockey and lacrosse star, coached soccer at Middlebury College 11 years where his teams won 64, lost 22 and tied 11 times.

He now conducts the Connecticut Soccer School and heads the Connecticut Junior Soccer Association which he founded seven years ago.

Joe and his wife, Elizabeth, are proud of their two sons; Joseph M., a two-time scholastic soccer All-American, and William T., a National Junior soccer selection like his older brother. Melissa A., a 7th-grader, completes the soccer-minded clan.

### Ingalls Award

Named in honor of the late University of Connecticut football coach and athletic director, D. Robert Ingalls, this award is presented annually to the captain, or co-captains, of the Husky football team.

This year the award is shared by last season's co-captains, Kirk J. Ferentz and Bernard E. Palmer.

Ferentz was a 6-foot-1, 205-pound linebacker from Upper St. Clair, Pennsylvania. Palmer, a Naugatuck native, was a 5-foot-11, 190-pound quarterback.

Glance at the names of the basketball players who won this award. Great performers, all. And along came Tony Hanson, the consummate conqueror of the court.

The Jamaican-born, 6-foot-5, 195-pound Hanson picked UConn from a long list of others seeking his talent elsewhere after an outstanding schoolboy career at Waterbury's Holy Cross High.

And he chose UConn to score 1,990 points, 702 in his last season, both school records. His senior shooting percentage of .523 and having played 111 consecutive games also are records.

It would take more than a page to cite Anthony Cary Hanson's hardwood heroics, but being named District One and New England Player of the Year last season surely enhanced his chances in the approaching professional draft.

There is something even more rewarding for this fellow. Working with retarded youngsters the past few summers has instilled a desire "to make a career of working with emotionally handicapped kids."

### Outstanding Senior Athlete Award

The University of Connecticut is headed for its 13th consecutive winning season in baseball under Coach Larry Panciera. Baseball is indeed synonymous with success at Storrs.

There's a 6-foot, 170-pound reason for this year's top rating in New England. It is Tom Germano, a Torrington native and control artist with an amazing right arm.

As this program went to press, Tom was awarded his eighth mound verdict in as many decisions and his earned run average hovered around 2.75. And he was named ECAC Division I Pitcher of the Week.

Last season, the torrid Torrington thrower pitched snake-eyes; 11 wins while losing just once and turning in a 1.31 ERA on a staff that led the nation in that department. His triumphs amounted to a school record.

Look for this young man to repeat his All-Yankee Conference, All-New England, All-Northeast, and All-America honors he won last season — along with a professional contract.

### Outstanding Senior Athlete Award

R. Paul Hunter



Just two years ago, Timothy R. Hunter won this award. Tonight, younger brother Paul retains the honor in the family. And he becomes the fourth UConn soccer player to wear the laurel wreath.

Paul was a first-round draft choice of the New York Cosmos and presently serves as captain of the North American Soccer League team's reserve squad.

"It was a tremendous opportunity for Paul, who is most deserving, and I'm pleased that one of our captains was chosen. I think it reflects the growing status of soccer at UConn," commented Coach Joe Morrone.

The trim, Texas native and Westport Staples High product was a starter all three years and was an All-Yankee Conference, NEISL Division I, and All-New England selection in both his junior and senior years.

He capped his collegiate career as a first team All-American last season and was one of three New England players chosen to participate in the Senior Bowl game.
